We seek investigators with interests in allergic skin disease and/or neurobiological mechanisms of itch or other sensory perceptions (e.g. pain) in the context of inflammation. The successful candidates will be housed within state-of-the-art research facilities at the newly established Centennial Biomedical Campus (<http://www.cvm.ncsu.edu/research/cbc.html>). This section of campus houses three departments with approximately 143 faculty who are an integral part of the greater research triangle park with established partnerships with nearby universities (UNC and Duke) and biomedical industry. Competitive salaries and startup funds will be commensurate with experience.

**Qualifications:** The successful candidate will hold a PhD and/or a DVM or MD, or equivalent in an appropriate discipline. Candidates must have a distinguished record in research including substantial publications in outstanding peer-reviewed journals and success in obtaining external research support.
