

Postdoc Position

The Chan lab at UCSF is recruiting a highly motivated and creative scientist to join our team as a Postdoctoral Research Scholar. We are affiliated with the UCSF Department of Ophthalmology and the F.I. Proctor Foundation. Our lab has a basic and translational research program that is focused on understanding the role of extracellular matrix proteolysis in normal and pathological corneal repair through the use of mouse models and the study of human tissue samples.

Candidates must have a recent Ph.D. and/or M.D. in immunology, cell or molecular biology, or related fields. Prior experience with mouse models, cell culture techniques, multi-color flow cytometry, and molecular and cellular immunology is desired. Responsibilities include designing/conducting experiments, collecting/analyzing data, preparing and presenting research findings at meetings, writing scientific manuscripts, and applying for fellowships/grants. The successful candidate will be a highly motivated individual with an outstanding publication record, excellent written/verbal English communication skills, strong organizational skills, and the ability to work independently.
