

Postdoctoral Fellow – Neuroscience and Diabetes.

Rutgers, the State University of New Jersey, is seeking a postdoctoral research fellow for the Child Health Institute of New Jersey at the Robert Wood Johnson Medical School. The position is available in El Ouaamari's group (<http://elouaamari.org>) to investigate the role of central and peripheral neurons in the function of insulin-producing cells in the context of obesity and diabetes.

Self-driven, creative and organized candidates with a PhD in neuroscience, biochemistry or molecular and cellular biology are encouraged to apply. The candidate must possess skills in manipulating and assessing neuronal activity. Prior experience working with rodents is required. Preference will be given to applicants who also have experience in 3D imaging of neuronal circuits. Candidates should have a strong record of productivity and publication in the field of neuroscience/neurobiology. Proficiency in oral and written English is required. Salary will be commensurate with experience, and follow NIH and Rutgers guidelines.

This position comes with the opportunity to interact with a diverse faculty inside and outside of the Rutgers community. Successful candidate will grow in a highly translational environment employing a multi-disciplinary approach to tackle questions relevant to diabetes and obesity.
