Postdoctoral Positions in Retinal Stem Cell Biology at the National Eye Institute

Several postdoctoral positions are available in the Retinal Development, Genetics, and Therapy Section of the Neurobiology, Neurodegeneration and Repair Laboratory (<https://nei.nih.gov/intramural/nnrl>) (Chief: Dr. Anand Swaroop) at the National Eye Institute, a part of National Institutes of Health in Bethesda, MD. The projects focus on modeling human retinal development and degeneration via stem cell-derived organoids in order to elucidate disease mechanisms and develop novel therapies. Applicants should have received a Ph.D. or M.D./Ph.D. within the last two years in Cell or Developmental Biology or similar fields with experience in stem cell culture and differentiation. Only candidates with strong motivation and publication record, as well as excellent communication and inter-personal skills will be considered. Annual stipend will be commensurate with experience and training.
